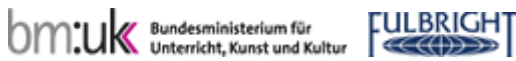

English Teaching Assistants help teach English language while serving as a cultural ambassador for U.S. culture. The age and academic level of classroom students varies by country, ranging from kindergarten to university level.
Requirements: University graduate, language proficiency varies by country.
Deadline: Approximately April through mid-October for the following year.

Classroom instruction 13 hours a week for one school year (Oct 1 – May 31).
Requirements: University graduate, working knowledge of German.
Stipend: see website
Deadline: Approximately Nov – Jan for following school year.

Duration: one year.
Requirements: 2 years post-secondary education
Benefits: Monthly stipend (see website), round-trip airfare to and from Georgia.
