SUBJECT: Instructor Eligibility to Teach UC San Diego Global Seminars

Dear Provost Evans, Director Galvin, and Dean Simmons,

The Undergraduate Council (UGC) and the Educational Policy Committee (EPC) considered the proposal to allow continuing Non-Senate Lecturers (AFT – Unit 18) to teach abroad through the Global Seminars Program. Following consultation with Academic Personnel, Campus Counsel, and Risk Management, UGC and EPC approve allowing Non-Senate Lecturers with a continuing appointment (requiring a minimum of 18 quarters of experience teaching at UC) to teach Global Seminars. The International Center's Study Abroad Office should contact Director of Academic Policy Development Kelly Lindlar in Academic Personnel Services for more details about the selection and hiring process for eligible Non-Senate Lecturers.
